Members participate in Show Up rides in the spring & fall, as long as the weather permits.

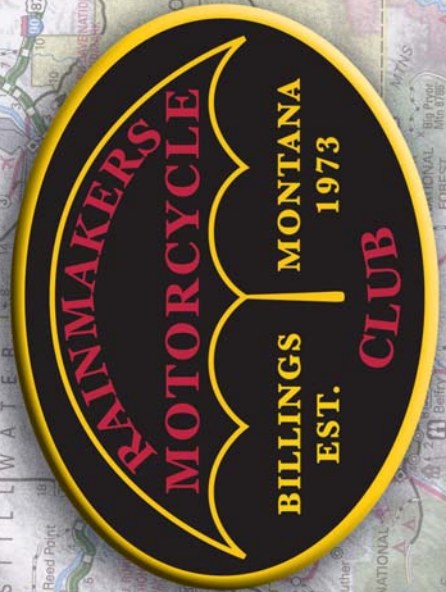
All rides depart from McDonalds on South Billings Blvd.

## SIPDE SAFETY

- S** - Scan all around you.
- I** - Identify potential hazards.
- P** - Predict what will happen.
- D** - Decide how to avoid problems.
- E** - Execute your plan.



## MOTORCYCLE SAFETY TIPS

- Besides regular maintenance, give your bike a quick visual inspection every time you ride.
- Clear your mind before you start to ride and never get on your bike after drinking.
- Group riding should be in a staggered formation, a minimum of 4 seconds apart.
- Look where you want to go - the bike will go where you look.
- If you can't see the driver's rearview mirrors, the driver can't see you.
- Wear protective clothing.
- Stop and take a break when fatigued.
- Ride at a pace comfortable for your abilities and appropriate for current road conditions.
